Where is **carmine** found?

Carmine is a bright red color. It is found in artificial flowers, paints, rouge, yogurt, cosmetics, food additives, and crimson ink.

How can you avoid contact with **carmine**?

Avoid products that list any of the following names in the ingredients:

- B Rose liquid
- CCRIS 1204
- Carmine
- Carmine (Coccus cacti L.)
- Cochineal (Coccus cacti L.)
- Cochineal extract lake
- EINECS 215-724-4
- FEMA No. 2242
- FEMA No. 2330
