Stiolto = Tiotropium Bromide & Olodaterol
Trelegy Ellipta = Fluticasone furoate & Umeclidinium Vilanterol
Incruse Ellipta = Umeclidinium
Tudorza Pressair = Aclidinium bromide

AVOID the following 12 hours prior:

Advair = Fluticasone & Salmeterol
Airduo = Fluticasone propionate & Salmeterol
Dulera = Mometasone & Formoterol
Foradil = Formoterol
Serevent = Salmeterol
Symbicort = Budesonide & Formoterol
Wixela = Fluticasone propionate & Salmeterol

AVOID the following 8 hours prior:

Atrovent = Ipratropium bromide
Maxair = Pirbuterol
Pro-Air, Proventil, Ventolin, Albuterol = albuterol
Xopenex = Levalbuterol

- **If you have a fever or asthma related symptoms, call prior to appointment**
- **No fever in last 24-48 hours**
- **You may continue to use nasal sprays and decongestants.**
- **Remember: 48 hours-notice needed to cancel appointments**
